Student Research Progress Report

Students in the CBMS Program are required to meet with their graduate committees at least once each year. MS students should meet with their committees near the anniversary of Certification. PhD students should meet with their committees near the anniversary of Prelim B. The purpose of each meeting is for the student to demonstrate satisfactory research progress toward achievement of their degree. A short progress report, (1 – 10 pages) should be prepared by the student and delivered to the committee members at least one week before the scheduled meeting. During the meeting, the student is expected to give a brief oral presentation of research progress. Additional requirements may be added at the discretion of the graduate committee.
