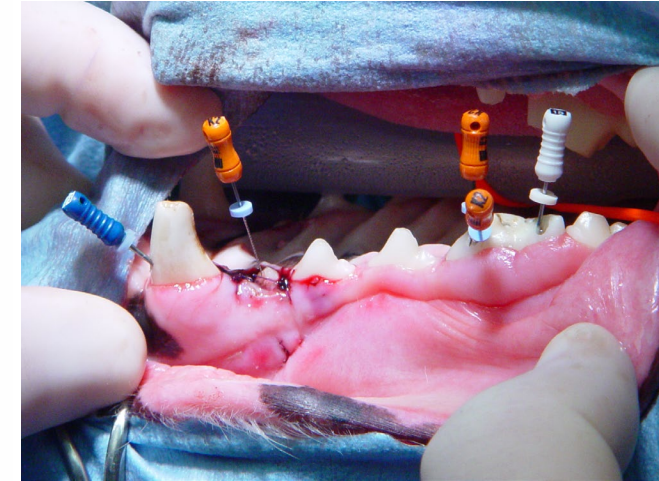




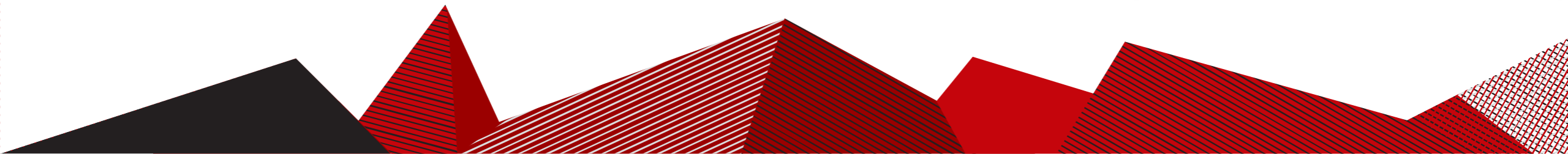
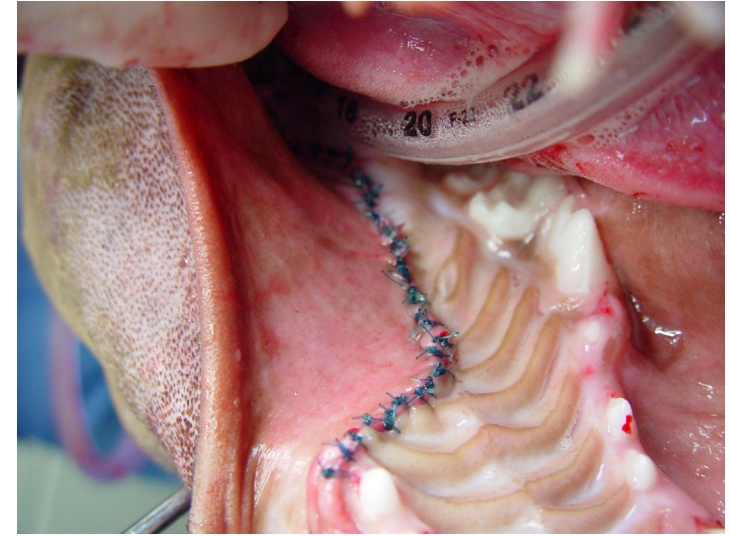

 - 7:00 ~ 6:30



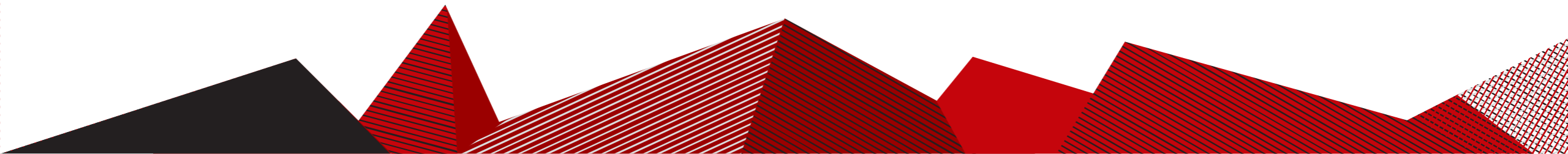
Education Goals
